The Certificate is designed to prepare non-TIM students for careers in the travel industry as well as provide working professionals the opportunity to expand or update their skills in the area of travel industry management. The courses for the certificate program will be delivered online, as well as in class.

Students must apply to the TIM school to be accepted to the certificate program prior to enrolling in upper division TIM courses. Admission requirements include the completion of 24 college-level credits and may include other admissions requirements.
